

English: We are Authors

Writing: As authors this half term the children will become poets! We are writing a poem called 'If I were in Charge of the World' based on a poem by Judith Viorst. We will also learn about letter writing using a text called 'This is how we do it' by Matt Lamothe.

Reading: For our class text we are continuing with 'James and the Giant Peach' by Roald Dahl.

Reading- Reading sessions will focus on developing children's vocabulary, inference, prediction, explanation and retrieval skills through discussion-based learning. We will explore a range of poetry, fiction and non-fiction texts throughout the half term, based on our enquiry or seasonal events. For example 'Noa and the Little Elephant' by Michael Foreman, 'Children Just Like Me' (DK) and 'Bodhi sees the world' by Marisa Aragon Ware.

Spellings: - your child will be given approximately 8 common exception words each week to practise. There will be no formal spelling test but we will look at these words each Friday. The children benefit hugely from being familiar with them.

How can you help at home? Listen to your child read at least 4 times a week; share a book or a text with your child and practice their weekly spellings.

Enquiry:

How are schools the same?

As Geographers, we will be learning about our local area and comparing it's features to Mantin in Malaysia. We will be using the language of physical and human geography to look at similarities and differences. We will also be learning about the continents and oceans.

Our challenge will be to create a poster to show how the schools we have looked at are the same.

Maths: We are Mathematicians

This half term we will be continuing to look at addition and subtraction, learning different strategies for how to cross the 10.

We will also learning about adding 3 numbers together and then how to add and subtract 2-digit numbers.

How can you help at home? Help your child apply their maths in practical situations. Practise counting objects in 2s and 5s. Ask for your child's help when adding simple numbers in the shop, or working out items for dinner etc. Have a look at the simple maths games on www.topmarks.co.uk

Wellbeing: We are Philosophers

We will be looking at the story "Chicken Clicking" by Jeanne Willis and Tony Ross to understand more about online safety.

Music: We are Musicians

As musicians, we will learn about Malaysian orchestral and instrument families, listen to some traditional Malaysian music and learn about a more modern Malaysian composer; Adeline Wong.
